## My New Uniform!

For your presentation, you are going to need to create a poster. Your poster must:
$\square$ Have a coloured in diagram of your uniform.
$\square$ Have the materials you will be using glued on.
$\square$ Have an explanation of why you chose the design and the materials. Your teacher will help you with this.
Follow the check lists to make sure you have everything.


## Your diagram (tick as you do):

$\square \quad$ Has the uniform you've chosen drawn on - this includes whether you chose pants/shorts/skirts/dresses.
$\square \quad$ Is coloured in with the uniform colours you have chosen as a team.
$\square \quad$ Has the materials you picked glued/stapled on around the sides with labels of what they will be used for - this includes the fabric and any buttons or zippers.

## Your explanation on your poster

$\square \quad$ Has a short explanation of why you chose the design and materials. You will explain more when you present to the class.
$\square \quad$ Explains why you chose the style of uniform (shorts, skirt, dress) etc.

## Your presentation

$\square \quad$ Everyone will have a turn at speaking
$\square \quad$ Explains why you think your style uniform is good for boys and girls
$\square \quad$ Explains why you think the old uniform needs changing
$\square \quad$ Explains why you think the materials will be suitable for all activities
$\square \quad$ Make sure you have checked the rubric and know what is expected of you.
